DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds

Please consult the AKC *Regulations for Agility Trials* for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower or higher height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Handlers may opt to run dogs measuring 22 inches and lower entered in regular classes in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Preferred dogs must run in their measured height division. Only dogs measuring into the 24 inch class may enter the 24 inch class. All others wishing to jump 24 inches must enter 24C.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that day of trials only. If a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section on the form for exhibitors to designate whether the dog has a valid jump height card or if the dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include the dog entered on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that a copy of a dog's jump height card be submitted with an entry form or shown at check-in.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and **must include the Agreement and Rules**.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE – JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial day thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Toys are allowed in the ring – they must be non-audible, must not be able to roll freely, and may not leave the handler's hand.
- Foots/treats are not allowed in the ring.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASS (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<https://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height. Eligible dogs may be entered in any level of ISC (Grade 1, 2, or 3). At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the above information may run any level. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

Jump Heights: DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS. However, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the qualifications required toward entering WTT or EOTT.

Please see the EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

COMMON ISC QUESTIONS

Who can enter ISC?

- Anyone who wants to try it. There are no restrictions on what levels you can enter in ISC and how many classes you enter on a single day. If you want to enter all ISC runs on Thursday, you may.

Does my dog have to jump at their ISC jump height?

- No. You can enter your dog in regular or preferred at the height they normally jump in AKC. However, runs at AKC jump heights will not count toward EOTT qualifications.

How do ISC courses compare with other AKC courses?

- ISC courses generally have more space between obstacles than other AKC courses. Most ISC courses designed by FCI judges have a really nice flow for the dogs but can be challenging for the handlers. In general, ISC level 1 courses have about the same level of difficulty as AKC Open courses. ISC level 2 courses have about the same difficulty as AKC Ex/Master courses but may include some Premier elements. In general, ISC level 3 courses are more difficult than courses offered in regular AKC trials.

How is ISC judged?

- ISC is judged using FCI rules. A summary of the scoring system is included in Chapter 14 of the "AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, Non-Regular Agility Classes International Sweepstakes Class".

How are the runs scored?

- Faults, then time.

What are Faults in ISC?

- Course Time Penalties are one (1) fault for each full second over Standard Course Time
- Standard (S) faults incur a five (5) point penalty and include:
 - A displaced bar or displaceable surface that the dog was to jump over
 - Missed down contact zones on all contacts and missed up contact zone on the teeter
 - Seesaw fly-off
 - Missed weave pole once entered correctly (assessed only once per set of weave poles)
 - Knocking down one of the boards of the Broad Jump. No other contacts faulted.
 - Breaking apart the Tire Jump
- Refusal (R) faults incur a five (5) point penalty and include:
 - Refusal at any obstacle
 - Run out at any obstacle
 - Dog exiting a contact obstacle prior to starting its descent on that obstacle
 - Failure to enter the Weave Poles properly
- Elimination Faults
 - Three (3) refusals and/or run-outs on a course
 - Dog running the wrong course, including touching the wrong obstacle with one (1) paw.
 - Dog/handler contact or Handler/equipment contact if it aids or was intended to aid the performance of the dog
 - Outside assistance to the handler/dog in the ring that aided the performance
 - Failure to complete all the obstacles on the course. Completing an obstacle is defined as:
 - Jumping over jumps and through tires in the proper direction
 - Starting descent on a contact obstacle
 - Going through the tunnels in the proper direction
 - Weaving all weave poles after proper entry

Maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope. Entry method is First Received.

Please be sure to have your e-mail address printed clearly on entry form. After closing date final confirmation and judging schedule will be sent out via e-mail.

*** ON-LINE Entry Procedure ***

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper (Mailed Entries) will be as follows: 100 runs online and 250 runs paper per day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

The **Flat-Coated Retriever Society of America (FCRSA)** and **French Bull Dog Club of America (FBDCA)** is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **40** runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary by **04/24/2024, 6PM (Eastern)**. Any request to withdraw that is received by Monday, **April 29, 2024 6PM (Eastern)** will only be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by **April 29, 2024** will receive a full refund. [We will shred your check].

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee. Refunds will not be issued for less than \$10.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials. The club will offer refunds for bitches that come into season after the closing date. A refund of the agility fee, less \$5.00 per day, will be issued provided written certification from a veterinarian is submitted on clinic letterhead no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first run of the day.

Injured dogs. The club will offer refunds for dogs injured after the closing date. Refund will be 50% of entry fees paid for the injured dog provided written certification from a veterinarian is submitted on clinic letterhead **prior to the start of the trial day**.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a padded artificial soccer turf. Ring size will be 108 x 80. Rubberized contacts and 24" weaves will be used.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. **The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.** Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group BEFORE the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of 2 separated regulation agility jumps, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

COVID - 19 NOTIFICATION

Following the recommended guidelines of the state and CDC, the **FCRSA & FBDCA** and Pinnacle Dog Sports will take all precautions to provide a safe and clean environment for exhibitors. Currently, masks are NOT required inside the building at Pinnacle Dog Sports. Due to the ever-changing situation, these rules may be adjusted closer to the actual trial date.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is **expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The **FCRSA & FBDCA**, Pinnacle Dog Sports and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The hosting club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the **FCRSA & FBDCA**, or any official thereof.

Pinch/prong collars, electric collars (dummy or not), or special training collars are prohibited on the trial grounds.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

All dogs **must be on leash at all times** except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The turf is very expensive to have professionally cleaned. Please take the time to walk your dog before their run(s). If your dog has a potty accident on the turf, there will be a \$20 cleaning charge.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Indoor crating space will be available for all dogs entered. In the event that you will be crating from your car/outdoors, please plan accordingly. You are required to place a tarp, plastic or mat underneath your crates or X-pens. Crates may be left overnight; however the **FCRSA & FBDCA** and Pinnacle Dog Sports will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Please consolidate crating as much as possible. A committee member or Pinnacle Dogs Sports representative will have the right to consolidate crating as needed.

Dogs are not allowed to relieve themselves on the building or shrubbery around the building.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. This includes at the hotel sites. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Dogs must remain in areas on NORTH side of the building. Do not let your dogs on the neighbor's property. No dogs are allowed in front of the building, by the pond area, or by docking area. Signs will be posted accordingly.

Outside food permitted.

No flash photography or light for video cameras permitted.

No grooming allowed in the building.

No Smoking inside the building.

No bitches in season permitted in the building.

No alcoholic beverages permitted during the trial.

HOTEL INFORMATION

These hotels have graciously agreed to accept our well-mannered dogs. A pet deposit may be required. Please check with hotels for policies and restrictions.
